SAFE TRAVEL ABROAD!



These **Top Ten Tips** will help ensure you are safe and secure during your trip abroad:

1. Carry a copy of your passport with you while in a country.
2. Remember to leave contact information (i.e. email address or phone number) with family and friends so they can get in touch with you abroad.
3. Choose a safe and secure hotel rather than a cheap one.
4. Travel in large groups rather than alone.
5. Refrain from carrying large bags while touring.
6. Be aware of your surroundings and avoid social distractions (e.g. mobile phones and mp3 players).

Often travellers fail to properly plan for trips abroad by not taking into account their personal security. The goal is to travel and enjoy yourself, but you must be aware of your security and safety. After the tragic events of September 11th, the world realised that airline safety and security are issues that affect all of us too. ***So here are a few tips that we recommend to help you have a safe flight and enjoyable trip...***

AIR TRAVEL SECURITY FOR YOUR NEXT FLIGHT!



- As soon as you arrive at the airport be sure to keep a close watch on your luggage and passport. Thieves often target airline travellers to steal their belongings while they go through airport screening, sleep or visit the toilets.
- On the plane choose a seat near the exit row. In the event there is an emergency, you will have an escape route close.
- If you can't get an exit row seat, choose a seat near the rear of the plane because in the event of a hijacking, the terrorists will focus their attention to the front of the plane as that's where they need to get to to take over the plane. With their attention focused to the front, this will give you time to get to your mobile phone and inform the authorities.
- Keep your mobile phone on your person. Don't place it in your hand luggage in the overhead compartment. You will need easy access to your phone in the event there is a problem on the plane to inform the authorities.
- Do not put your passport or your money with your belongings in the overhead compartment. Keep them on your person. Otherwise someone could easily steal them while you are sleeping or in the toilet.
- Watch and listen to the flight attendant's safety briefing before the flight. Even if you are a frequent flier and have heard the speech a million times, the instructions they provide may save your life.

7. Surrender your valuables if confronted by thieves - they can be replaced.
8. Contact the police immediately and report it if you are victimised.
9. Be extra careful when using public transport abroad - avoid using crowded buses if possible.
10. Get sound security advice by contacting your embassy or consulate.

- Notice who is seated around you. If you do observe strange behaviour from another passenger, be sure to notify a flight attendant immediately. *Remember that airline travel security is everyone's business.*
